LEE COUNTY LOCAL BUSINESS TAX RECEIPT

MISCELLANEOUS MAINTENANCE OR REPAIR & PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

Property Maintenance & Miscellaneous Maintenance or Repair Service, etc.

A local business tax receipt to perform these services does not allow a business to enter into repair, installation or construction in the building trades or specialty fields. Construction, electrical, plumbing, A/C, painting, roofing, screening or re-screening of anything other than windows, doors and lanais that are built in the structure of the roof of the home (no aluminum work), carpentry, cabinet & millwork, excavation, masonry, drywall & plastering, etc. In order to perform work in these trades or specialty fields, you must obtain a State Contractor License or County Competency Card and must produce evidence of such license at the time application is made for a local business tax receipt.

This type of local business tax receipt is very restrictive in nature; (Examples: clean out garage, hanging drapery rods, peep hole installation, changing door knobs, replacing toilet flush kits, etc.)

Advertising in any way to conduct services for compensation without a proper local business tax receipt is in violation of Florida Statute 205.

Florida Statute 489.127 Prohibitions, penalties. **–no person shall:**

- Engage in the business, advertise him/herself or act in the capacity of a contractor, or a business organization available to engage in the business or act in the capacity of a contractor or perform work for which a building permit is required, pursuant to part VII of chapter 553.
- Willfully or deliberately disregard or violate any municipal or county ordinance relating to uncertified or unregistered contractors.
- Any unlicensed person who violates any provision of subsection (1) commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
- Any unlicensed person who commits a violation of subsection (1) after having been previously found guilty of such violation commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or 775.083.
